

JOHN Q. CITIZEN CHARGES AND SENTENCING EXPOSURE

Tenn. Code Ann § 40-35-115: Judge may order sentences to run consecutively

if he finds defendant if defendant has devoted life to criminal acts as a major source of livelihood; or the defendant is an offender whose record of criminal activity is extensive; or

if the offense was committed while the defendant was on probation.
